

BANANA SLAP™

THE MONKEY SEE,
MONKEY DO GAME!

When two identical cards show up,
be the first to do what monkeys do
or to slap the banana to win the most cards!

This game is completely bananas and is sure
to have you howling with laughter.

A great way to monkey around with family and friends.

Contents

1 Wooden Banana

72 Cards:

48 "monkey do" cards



16 "slap the banana" cards



8 "banana" cards



Object of the game

Be the quickest to do what monkeys do or to slap the banana to win the most cards.

Preparation

Place the Banana in
the middle of the
players.

Choose one player to
shuffle and deal all
the cards equally.

Players make a pile
with their cards and
keep them face down
in front of them.



Playing the game

The player to the left of the dealer goes first.

Players take turns turning over the top card of their pile and
placing it face up to form their discard pile (If only two players
are playing, they both turn their cards over at the same time).

As soon as 2 identical cards show up, it's monkey time!



As soon as 2 identical "monkey do" cards appear on top of the discard piles, the first player to do exactly what the monkey is doing while grunting, screeching or howling like a monkey wins all the cards from all the discard piles. The cards just won are placed face down under the pile of cards in front of the winning player.

If 2 identical "banana" cards appear at the same time on top of the discard piles, all the cards from the discard piles go on the wooden banana. The last player to turn over a card starts the next round.



If 2 identical "slap the banana" cards appear at the same time on top of the discard piles, the first player to slap the wooden banana wins the cards on the banana and all the cards from the discard piles. The cards just won are placed face down under the pile of cards in front of the winning player.

Very Important

If players make mistakes like slapping the banana when they shouldn't or not doing correctly what the monkeys are doing on the cards, their discard pile goes on the banana.

When a player wins a hand, he is the first to start the new round by turning over a new card. When a player makes a mistake, he is the first to restart.

When a player turn over a card, he cannot peek at it before it hits the table to be fair to the other players.



When a player has no cards left, he is eliminated.

If two or more players make a monkey sound at the same time and both have the correct position, the last one to have turned over a card wins the hand.

When 2 players are left in the game there are 2 options :

- 1 - the one with the most cards wins
- 2 - they continue playing using the two player rule : they turn over their cards at the same time until 2 identical cards show up.



Winning

The player with the most cards wins. Special mention can be given to the funniest monkey sounds.



Fast and Furious Version

This game can also be played in pure "slapping mode" in which players just slap the wooden banana every time two identical cards appear.

The first player to slap the banana gets all the cards turned over in that hand.

If players slap the banana by mistake, they are eliminated.
