## Rules

### Intro

How well do you know your family and friends?

Find out with Do You Know Your Peeps?

Test how well you know your loved ones by guessing their favorite things or how they would react in certain everyday or fanciful situations.

This light-hearted trivia game comprises categories that cover anything from school to personality to magic. Needless to say, if you didn't already, you'll get to know your peeps a whole lot better!

### Object of the game

To win the game, be the first one to win one Question Card from each of the categories: Favorites, School, Hobbies, Magic and Personality.

### Playing the game

Each player receives 3 Answer Cards (A, B, and C).

The person with the weirdest laugh in the room kicks off the game as the "Guesser" for the first round.

The Guesser chooses a Question Card from the category of their choice.

The Guesser reads the question and the 3 possible answers out loud.

The other players secretly decide which of the 3 choices best represents what their response is.

If more than one answer applies, choose the response that best represents you.



### Remember:

*Not every question will apply to actual life circumstances. When answering such a question, consider it hypothetical: What WOULD you do IF you were in that situation? For example, under the category "School", grown-ups would have to go back to the time when they were in school and imagine IF such a thing happened to them back then, what WOULD they have done.*

Once everyone has selected their answer, they place the corresponding Answer Card face down on the table (either A, B, or C).

The Guesser then tries to guess each player's answer, in any order.

The players reveal their actual answers to prove them right or wrong.

If the answer was guessed right, the card stays up on the table, otherwise it is flipped face down.

### Winning a card

In order to win the Question Card at play, the Guesser must guess at least half of the answers correctly.

**3 PLAYERS:** The Guesser must guess the other 2 player's answers correctly to win the Question Card at play.

**4-5 PLAYERS:** The Guesser must guess at least 2 answers correctly to win the Question Card.

**6-7 PLAYERS:** The Guesser must guess at least 3 answers correctly to win the Question Card.

**8-9 PLAYERS:** The Guesser must guess at least 4 answers correctly to win the Question Card.

**10 PLAYERS:** The Guesser must guess at least 5 answers correctly to win the Question Card.

The game moves clockwise as the next player becomes the next Guesser and chooses a new Question Card from any category.

### Note:

*As a group, you may decide to play with certain categories only. In that case you need to determine in advance which categories you will play with and how many cards you need for each in order to win the game.*

### Winning the game

When a player wins one Question Card from each category at play, they trigger the end of the game. Make sure each player has been the Guesser the same amount of times and play a few more turns if necessary so that all players are on the same fair playing field.

Once each player has been the Guesser the same amount of times, the game ends.

If two or more players are tied with one Question Card from each category, they share the victory.

If only one player has one Question Card from each category, then they know their friends and family the best and they are the sole winner!
